
As America's population ages and cancer cases rise, oncologists and nursing professionals burnout.

Fay Hollobay, a clinical health psychologist, ended an intensive care unit in Chicago, she was struck by the suffering of a patient whose condition had suddenly deteriorated during cancer treatment.
